NSPE is accepting applications for a summer internship program at the Victor O. Schinnerer Company, Inc. in Chevy Chase Maryland.

The Milton F. Lunch internship gives engineering students the unique opportunity to study engineering claims in a professional setting. In addition to providing eight weeks of summer employment, the internship also comes with a \$7000.00 stipend plus a \$2000.00 housing allowance should the winning recipient live outside a reasonable commuting distance from Schinnerer's Chevy Chase, Maryland office.

Submission deadline is January 15, 2005.

Qualifications:

1. Completed two years of engineering study in an EAC-ABET accredited program prior to the internship's start.
2. Belong to the NSPE as a Student Member
3. Have a minimum GPA of 2.5 on a scale of 4.0
4. U.S. citizen
5. Plan to enter the engineering profession upon graduation.

Include with application:

1. Official transcript
2. Three recommendations from individuals who have either taught, mentored or worked with the applicant. One of these people must be a professional engineer.
3. A 2-3 page personal statement of the student's career goals, reasons for applying and what the student hopes to gain from the internship.
4. A 5 page writing sample, which may be a paper submitted for a class assignment.
