Undergraduates from across the University are welcome to submit an abstract on their mentored research for the Undergraduate Research Poster Reception. Research either performed on-campus with a University of Pittsburgh mentor or off-campus at another institution is appropriate.

The deadline for abstract submission is Friday, 18 September. All abstracts should be submitted through the Science2009 web site. Abstracts are limited to be 150-200 words and should be written in such a way as to make them understandable to your fellow students. Note that submitting an abstract automatically registers you for attendance at Science2009.

Abstracts will be reviewed and presenters will be notified via email by 25 September about whether their abstract has been accepted. Presenters are invited to attend a poster-preparation workshop on 2 October at 4:00 pm in Chevron Science Center Room 706.
