CHECKING FOR AVAILABLE COURSES, VIEWING YOUR WEEKLY SCHEDULE, READING COURSE DESCRIPTIONS, AND VIEWING YOUR ACCOUNT

Find information like: When is Intro to Psychology offered? When is my Calc 1 class? What will be taught in Physics 174? Do I owe the University money?

To check on availability of courses through Peoplesoft please follow instructions below.

- Go to: <http://my.pitt.edu>
- Login with your Pitt ID and password.
- Select the Student Services tab on the upper right hand corner of the screen.
- Click on 'Link to Your Student Center' in the middle of the screen.
- Select 'Self Service' then 'Class Search/Browse Catalog'.
- Type in 4 digit term code (i.e. 2091 for Fall 2008); click 'Go'.

CHECKING FOR ENGINEERING APPROVED SOCIAL SCIENCE OR HUMANITIES ELECTIVES

Find information like: Will History 0600 count toward my Engineering elective requirements? What do the breadth and depth requirements entail?

CHECKING COURSE DESCRIPTIONS FOR ARTS AND SCIENCES CLASSES

Find information like: What kind of things will I learn about in Anthropology 1780? How do different sections of the same elective differ from one another? These course descriptions are often more detailed than those in Peoplesoft, however, Engineering classes are not listed on this site.
